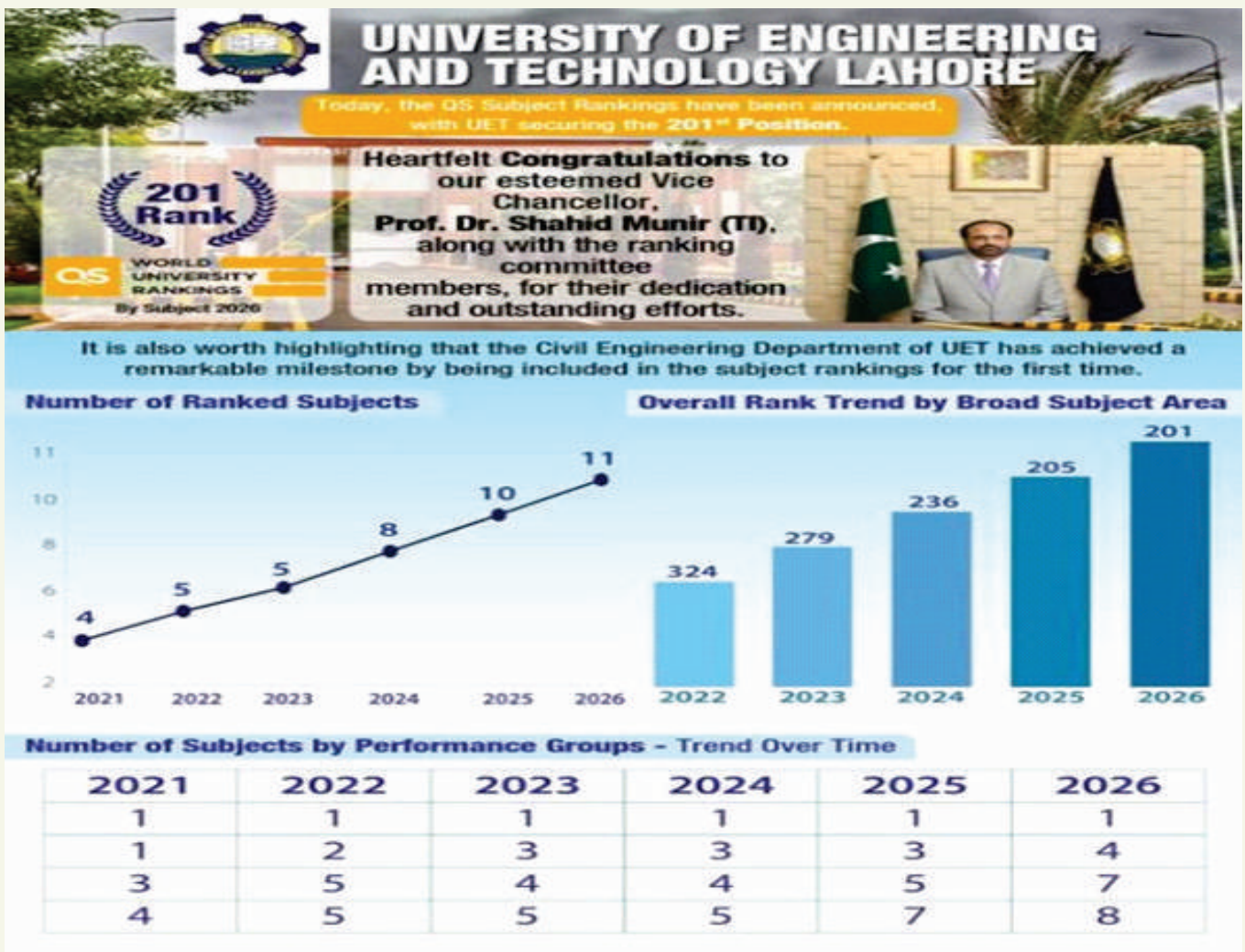
UET Lahore Achieves Improved Global Ranking in Engineering & Technology

QS World University Ranking by Subject 2026: Official Results Announced

The improved ranking and new subject inclusion underscore UET's strengthening position among leading institutions worldwide and its ongoing pursuit of excellence in engineering education and research.

This achievement reflects the institution's continued commitment to academic excellence, research quality, and innovation. The progress has been attributed to the strategic leadership of the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Shahid Munir (TI), along with the dedicated efforts of the university's Ranking Committee.

The University of Engineering and Technology (UET) has recorded a notable improvement in its global standing in the field of Engineering & Technology, rising from 205th to 201st position in the latest international rankings.

Faculty of Natural Sciences, Humanities & Islamic Studies 80 million Alumni-Led Expansion Elevates Department of Islamic Studies



The extension of the Department of Islamic Studies at the University of Engineering and Technology (UET) Lahore has been successfully completed, thanks to the initiative and generous support of the university's alumni. Mr. Umair Javed, a graduate of the University of Engineering and Technology (UET) Lahore, has built an extraordinary global career by combining engineering excellence with visionary entrepreneurship.

He earned his BSc in Electrical Engineering from UET Lahore (1994–1998), where he received the Best Final Year Project award for developing a 3D Flight Simulator—an early reflection of his strength in complex systems and innovative problem-solving. He later completed his MS in Computer Science at Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS), graduating as the top student of his batch and receiving the Presidential Gold Medal. Further advancing his expertise, he pursued executive education at Carnegie Mellon

University in Software Process Improvement (CMMi), gaining mastery in scalable engineering systems.

Building a Global Technology Enterprise

Building on this strong academic foundation, Mr. Javed co-founded Tixel in 2008 with five partners and an initial investment of \$500. What began as a small venture within a university lab has grown into a U.S.-headquartered AI and digital transformation company, serving Fortune 500 corporations and high-growth startups across North America and the Middle East.

Tixel specializes in AI-driven systems, enterprise modernization, SaaS platforms, and large-scale digital transformation, enabling organizations to scale AI from pilot initiatives to full operational deployment. Under his leadership, the company has been featured on the Inc. 5000 list of America's Fastest-Growing Companies (2022–2024) and recognized by the Financial Times, Clutch Global, and Forbes Technology Council.

Achieving International Recognition and Thought Leadership

Beyond building a successful enterprise, Mr. Javed has emerged as a prominent global voice on applied AI. In 2025, he spoke at World Summit AI Qatar and TechCrunch Disrupt San Francisco, sharing insights on translating AI strategy into measurable outcomes. He also participated in TechCrunch All Stage (Boston) and led invitation-only roundtables for CIOs and CTOs on the Future of Work and AI. As a member of the Forbes Business Council, he regularly contributes thought leadership on AI strategy, enterprise leadership, and innovation.

In addition to his industry leadership, Mr. Javed is an active angel investor and mentor. 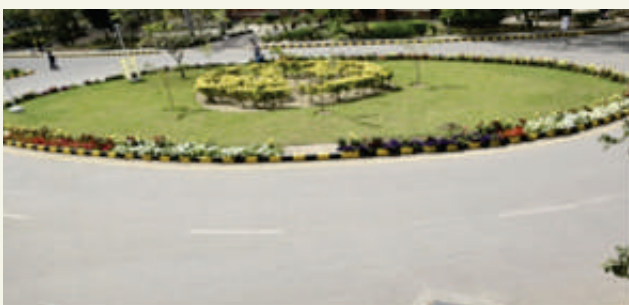

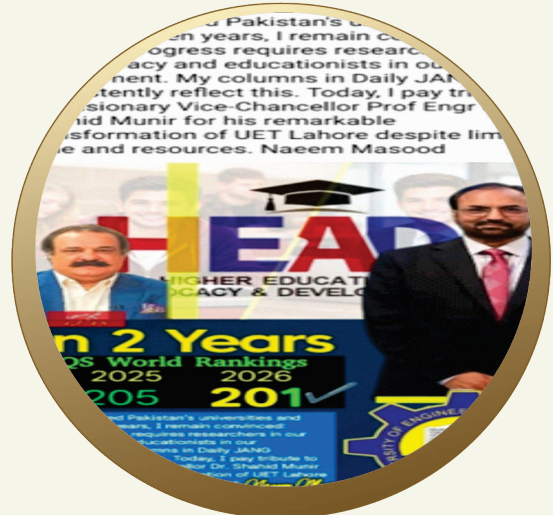
VC Highlights UET's Global Ranking on Morning Pakistan

ORIC Steering Committee Reviews Research Strategy and Innovation Priorities



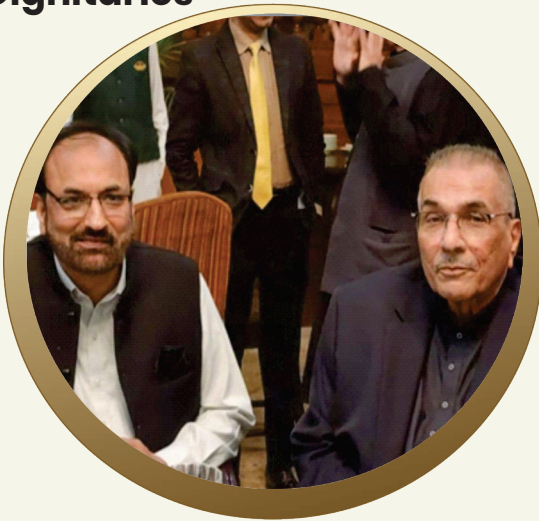
